ST. LOUISIAN DARRYL JONES JOINS GAMING COMMISSION

JEFFERSON CITY, Missouri - Darryl Jones of St. Louis joined the Missouri Gaming Commission for his first meeting at the Commission's May 25th meeting. Governor Matt Blunt announced the appointment of Jones to the Commission on May 2nd. He replaced former Commissioner Jack Gant whose term expired April 29th.

Commissioner Jones received his undergraduate degree in mathematics from St. Louis University and an MBA from Webster College. He is a partner with Aramark-Jay Concessions, LLC, HMS/Host-D&D Concessions, LLC, and TRI-TEC, Inc. His companies manage foodservice for the St. Louis Public Schools, concessions for Lambert International Airport, concessions and catering for the St. Louis Convention Center and certain foodservice sales at the Edward Jones Dome.

Jones also currently serves as the Chairman of the Garden District Commission, on the Fontbonne University Board of

Trustees, and as a Board member of Our Little Haven. His former community service includes serving as secretary/treasurer of the Missouri Housing Development Commission, and Chairman of the St. Louis Metropolitan Sewer District.
