MGC Welcomes New Commissioner

RIVERSIDE, Missouri - The Missouri Gaming Commission welcomes new Commissioner Larry Plunkett Sr. of Greenville. Plunkett, 58, is a retired Missouri State Highway Patrolman, and a former Wayne County Sheriff. He is President of MPS Inc., which conducts polygraph examinations.

MGC Executive Director Gene McNary says "I commend Governor Blunt's appointment. Mr. Plunkett brings considerable law enforcement experience, and represents a part of Missouri not currently represented on the Commission." McNary adds "Mr. Plunkett will be quick to learn the importance of the gaming industry, and its extensive tax benefits which support Early Childhood and other programs."

Larry Plunkett Sr. will fill the unexpired term of Commissioner Floyd Bartch who resigned in July of 2006. One vacancy remains on the five member commission.
