POSITION SUMMARY

This position manages a Web development team of two professionals within the Information Technology Section. Website design and maintenance, as well as, knowledge of designing forms are critical duties of this position. Other responsibilities include, but are not limited to conducting testing to ensure functionality; updating and supporting project development as needed; ensuring enhancements are in compliance with higher echelon directives and are cost effective. This position works with two other co-managers providing a full array of technical expertise in system maintenance, integration of new technology and enhancements to existing systems. Incumbent will participate in multiple phases of long-term projects to include but not limited to analyzing, designing, documenting, testing and maintaining new application modules as well as system upgrades. This position is responsible for providing customer service to both internal and external customers with a focus of supporting application development projects, enhancements and or maintenance relating to the design and documentation of functional work processes. Supervisory experience is preferred.

Desired skills: Ability to use C#, SQL, JAVA, Html or similar languages.

QUALIFICATIONS

One or more years of experience as an Information Technologist IV with the Missouri Uniform Classification and Pay System. Experience should be in one or more of the following areas: application development/ support, business systems analysis, databases, systems programming, end user support, and/ or web technologies.
