**PROPOSED RESCISSION**

**11 CSR 45-4.085 Expiration of Temporary License.** This rule established a time frame for the automatic expiration of temporary licenses.

*PURPOSE: This rule is being rescinded because it is obsolete, in that the commission no longer issues temporary licenses to Class A or B licensees.*

*AUTHORITY: section 313.807, RSMo [2000] 2016. Original rule filed Dec. 3, 2007, effective May 30, 2008. Amended: Filed March 1, 2018.*

*PUBLIC COST: This proposed rescission will not cost state agencies or political subdivisions more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.*

*PRIVATE COST: This proposed rescission will not cost private entities more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.*

*NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND NOTICE TO SUBMIT COMMENTS: Anyone may file a statement in support of or in opposition to this proposed rescission with the Missouri Gaming Commission, PO Box 1847, Jefferson City, MO 65102. To be considered, comments must be received within thirty (30) days after publication of this notice in the **Missouri Register**. A public hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, May 1, 2018, at 10:00, in the Missouri Gaming Commission's Hearing Room, 3417 Knipp Drive, Jefferson City, Missouri.*
