

# Fantasy Sports Contests

The Missouri Fantasy Sports Consumer Protection Act went into effect August 28, 2016. Fantasy sports companies who submitted an application by October 1, 2016 are able to continue operations until a determination is made regarding their suitability for licensure in Missouri. Five fantasy sports companies who applied by the October 1<sup>st</sup> deadline are currently offering fantasy sports contests in Missouri. Three of those companies have been licensed and two still have their applications pending. Five additional applications were received after the October 1, 2016 deadline. Those applications are in various stages of completion and are currently being processed. Below are the fantasy sports companies operating in Missouri:

The above table shows the amount collected in annual operation fees from licensed operators or from those companies who made application prior to October 1, 2016. Annual operation fees are collected each calendar year at the rate of 11.5% of the licensed operator's net revenue from the previous calendar year, and they are due on April 15<sup>th</sup> of each year. All revenue collected is placed in the Gaming Proceeds for Education fund.
