Colonel Roger Stottlemire Named Deputy Director of Enforcement

Jefferson City, Missouri, Wednesday, August 15, 2006. The Missouri Gaming Commission welcomes retired Missouri Highway Patrol Colonel Roger Stottlemire to the position of Deputy Director of Enforcement.

MGC Executive Director Gene McNary says "Roger Stottlemire brings a wealth of professional experience, as well as an outstanding reputation within law enforcement agencies in Missouri. His 32 years of law enforcement experience will enhance our regulatory efforts, and will provide coordinated direction".

Stottlemire begins his new position September 1, 2006. He is the fourth Deputy Director of Enforcement since the MGC's inception in 1992.

Colonel Stottlemire was born in Unionville, Missouri. A 1967 graduate of Unionville High School, he attended the University of Missouri-Columbia before joining the Marine Corps in 1968. He served as an infantryman during the Vietnam War and earned the Purple Heart.
