

COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 16-019  
REGARDING EXCLUSION OF AN INDIVIDUAL FROM  
EXCURSION GAMBLING BOATS AND FACILITIES IN MISSOURI

APRIL 27, 2016

WHEREAS, pursuant to 11 CSR 45-15.030 the Missouri Gaming Commission (the "Commission") has the authority to place a person on the Exclusion List for conviction of a felony in any jurisdiction of any crime involving morale turpitude or of a crime involving gaming, violating any provision of Chapter 313, RSMo, or any rule promulgated by the Missouri Gaming Commission, or performing any act or having a notorious or unsavory reputation which would adversely affect public confidence and trust in gaming; or has their name on any valid and current exclusion list from another jurisdiction in the United States; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 11 CSR 45-15.010, placement on the Exclusion List prohibits such person from entering or having contact of any kind with any Missouri riverboat gaming operation; and

WHEREAS, Paul G. Parker II, pled guilty on April 9, 2015, and was convicted on July 16, 2015, in The United States District Court Eastern District of Missouri of one felony count of Mail Fraud and three counts of Filing a False Tax Return, felonies involving moral turpitude. He was sentenced to 36 months in prison, supervised probation of 3 years and restitution of \$281,973.00. Mr. Parker also had an extensive gambling history at Missouri casinos with losses of \$589,227.31 during the calendar years of 2012, 2013 and 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commission hereby finds that Paul G. Parker II is eligible for permanent placement on the Exclusion List, and the Commission directs the Executive Director to issue a Notice of Exclusion to Paul G. Parker II.
