

**COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 18-063
REGARDING EXCLUSION OF PAMELA TABATT FROM
EXCURSION GAMBLING BOATS AND FACILITIES IN MISSOURI**

WHEREAS, pursuant to 11 CSR 45-15.030 the Missouri Gaming Commission (the "Commission") has the authority to place a person on the Exclusion List for having been convicted of a felony in any jurisdiction of any crime involving moral turpitude or of a crime involving gaming, violating any provision of Chapter 313 RSMo or any rule promulgated by the Missouri Gaming Commission, performing any act or having a notorious or unsavory reputation which would adversely affect public confidence and trust in gaming, or having her name on any valid and current exclusion list from another jurisdiction in the United States; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 11 CSR 45-15.010, placement on the Exclusion List prohibits such person from, entering or having contact of any kind with any Missouri riverboat gaming operation; and

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2016, Pamela Tabatt pled guilty in the United States District Court Eastern District of Missouri to of one count of Conspiracy to Distribute Controlled Substances and Controlled Substance Analogues, in violation of Title 21, U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and 813, one count of Conspiracy to Introduce and Receive Misbranded Drugs in Interstate Commerce, in violation of Title 21, U.S.C. §§ 331(a) and 333(a)(2), and four counts of Money Laundering, in violation of Title 18, U.S.C. § 1957. All counts are considered felonies involving moral turpitude. On July 20, 2016, the Court sentenced Ms. Tabatt to 12 years and 6 months imprisonment, followed by three years of supervised probation, and ordered her to pay a \$25,000 fine. Under the terms of her probation, Ms. Tabatt has been ordered to participate in a gambling addiction treatment program as approved by the probation officer, provide verification of attendance, and is prohibited from engaging in any form of gambling.

Ms. Tabatt has an extensive gambling history. At Isle of Capri Casino Boonville, she had a lifetime loss of \$3,494 between 2013 and 2014. In 2010 and 2018, her wagers at Lumière Place Casino and Hotels totaled \$10,687, and her lifetime losses totaled \$1,123. Between 2011 and 2015 Ms. Tabatt had a total coin in of \$1,509,836 and losses of \$147,897.57 at Hollywood Casino St. Louis. At Ameristar Casino St. Charles, Ms. Tabatt wagered a total of \$5,925,640 and lost \$552,843 between 2001 and 2015. In the years 2006, 2009, and 2012, Ms. Tabatt wagered a total of \$35,476 and lost a total of \$3,114 at Mark Twain Casino.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commission hereby finds that Pamela Tabatt is eligible for permanent placement on the Exclusion List, and the Commission directs the Executive Director to issue a Notice of Exclusion to Pamela Tabatt.
