

**MISSOURI GAMING COMMISSION
COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 20-010
REGARDING FINDING OF SUITABILITY
AND LICENSURE OF TWIN RIVER WORLDWIDE HOLDINGS, INC.**

June 30, 2020

WHEREAS, Twin River Worldwide Holdings, Inc. (“Twin River”), has applied to the Missouri Gaming Commission (the “Commission”) for a Class A license to develop and operate Class B Licensees in the State of Missouri; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Commission hereby makes a finding that Twin River, as a Class A Licensee, is suitable to develop and operate Class B Licensees, namely IOC – Kansas City, Inc., which has a Class B License to operate Isle of Capri Casino, Kansas City; and

RESOLVED, the license issued to the applicant as provided herein shall be subject to full and complete compliance by the applicant with Sections 313.800, RSMo *et seq.*, as amended from time to time, and 11 CSR 45-1 *et seq.*, as amended from time to time (collectively, the “Riverboat Gambling Act and Regulations”), and subject to any and all conditions set forth or that may be set forth in the Riverboat Gaming Act and Regulations or by the Commission, from time to time; and

RESOLVED, the license issued to Twin River as provided herein shall be subject to the Licensee maintaining all required governmental permits and approvals for the operation of its excursion gambling boats; and

RESOLVED, the license issued to Twin River as provided herein shall be subject to any penalty or to suspension or revocation based on any pending or subsequent investigative findings by the Commission with regard to the Licensee, its agents, or employees; and

RESOLVED, pursuant to Section 313.807.1 RSMo, the Commission may, at any time, reopen the applicant’s licensing hearing; and

RESOLVED, that the Commission hereby issues a Class A license to Twin River Worldwide Holdings, Inc. for a period of one (1) year beginning on the date that the actual physical license is delivered by the Executive Director or the Deputy Director of the Missouri Gaming Commission to the applicant.
